Hispanic Outreach: The AUMC Church Council on June 18 approved a position for Associate Pastor for Hispanic/Latino Outreach, effective July 1. Rev. Luz Zuleta will work 10 hours per week at the Immanuel campus with special focus on connecting with our Latino brothers and sisters in the area. Rev. Eduardo Carrillo is already active in the community, especially along the Rt. 236 corridor, and participates in the food distribution program at Immanuel. Rev. Zuleta's appointment will complement Rev.
