

Thank you for considering applying for the 2017-2018 Student Leader Intern (SLI) Program!

Here is a quick run-down of some frequently asked SLI Program questions.

What is a SLI?

A SLI is a Student Leader Intern, which is a one-year program where students can participate in the planning and preparation of upcoming youth events while learning leadership and team-building skills.

What do SLI's do?

Student Leader Interns assist Trish and other youth leaders with all of the tasks that need to be completed to make a Grid event run smoothly. These tasks cover everything from set-up and logistics, to helping with technical aspects of Ramp meetings, to leading activities, like games and small group discussions.

Who can be a SLI?

All students that are at least in the 8th grade (as of the 2017-2018 school year) are eligible to apply to the SLI program. Youth Band members are eligible to apply to the SLI program, understanding that they may have limited availability on Sunday afternoons during sound-checks.

When do SLIs meet?

SLI's will have planning meetings during the Sunday School hour approximately twice a month. SLIs will also be expected to be at the church at 4:30 PM on Sunday afternoons to help with set-up before Ramp meetings. Additional meetings may be set-up if there is a larger project to complete. ***Orientation and preparation meetings for the fall Ramp program will begin in early August.***

What is expected of me if I am a SLI?

As the title entails, this is a leadership position in the youth group and all leaders are expected to take their roles seriously. You will be expected to participate in activities and bring encouragement and excitement to our Sunday night meetings. SLIs will be expected to be an example of kindness, friendliness, servitude, and love to the other students in Ramp. And you will be expected to help – not just with logistics, but with shaping and molding our youth program into a great place where young people can fellowship and grow with God.
