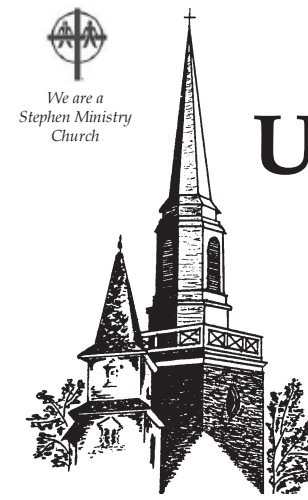
SACRAMENTS CLASS for 3rd-5th Graders

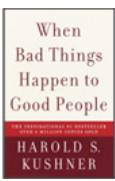


