VIM Trip to West Virginia Oct. 21-27 - AUMC is sponsoring a 21-member mission trip to Brenton, West Virginia (Wyoming County) with the Appalachian Service Project (ASP). Brenton is only 340 miles from Annandale. AUMC has sent summer youth teams to

ASP for over 10 years and we will now be participating in an adult mission trip for the first time. We will be doing relational ministry and home repairs—typical ASP projects include roofing, drywall and insulation, wheelchair ramps, plumbing, electrical, building process, foundation repair, painting, stairs and floor repairs.

Cost for the trip: \$525 to include transportation, lodging, meals and all construction materials. Volunteers who cannot go for the full 7 days (5 work days and 2 travel days) are welcome.
