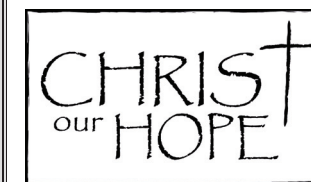
The 2012 Children's Lenten Mission project is to raise \$1,000 for the Cambine
