AARP Safe Driving Course for Seniors (55 & over) - The AARP Safe Driving Course for Seniors is coming to AUMC again in June. Those who complete the two-day course will receive a certificate to submit to their auto insurance company. This often results in a reduction of the insurance premium. The course will be held Monday and Tuesday, June 18 and 19, in AUMC's Media Center, 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with an hour off for lunch. The cost is \$12.00 for AARP members (bring your card) and \$14.00 for non-members. Since space is limited, you must register ahead of time by calling Jane Underhill (703-573-2056). If you get a machine, leave your name and telephone number, and we will confirm your reservation. No need to pay in advance. Pay on the first day of the course – cash or checks made out to AARP.
