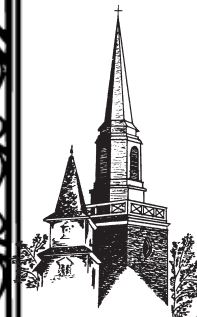
NEW YEAR REMINDERS
